Minutes of the Board Meeting

November 6, 2017

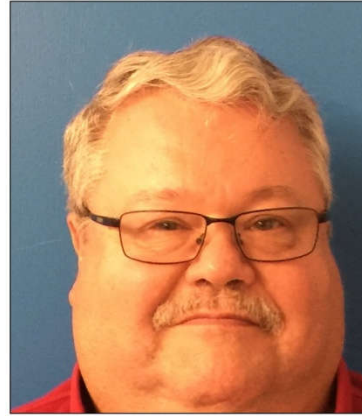

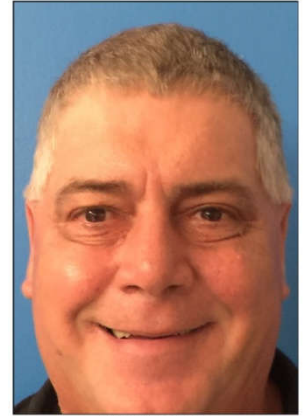

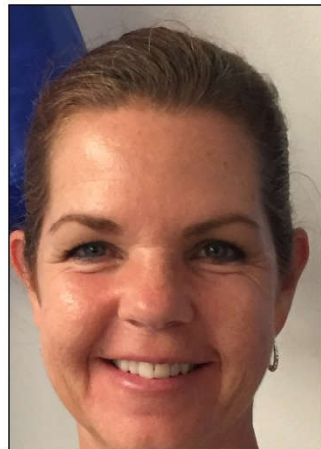
