Boaters Park

Want a quick getaway for an hour or two? This is ideal for a family outing and picnic. Just a mile west of the club on the Dania Cutoff canal. Excellent docks, water, electric, bathrooms, pavilions and tables.

Fort Lauderdale Sandbar

Sandbar is; On the Intracoastal at the intersection of the new river. It used to be Gilligan's Island until the 90's when the palm trees succumbed to the wakes of boats and the sand eroded till underwater. It is now three feet under at high tide. Some people know this as The Triangle. If you go north from Port Everglades, under the 17th street bridge and forget to turn, you will end up on the sandbar.

Sylvan Lake (sometimes referred to as Lake Sylvia)

Immediately south of Bahia Mar, East of the Intracoastal. Stay left (east side) of canal to avoid grounding in the center of the bay. An approved anchorage with 9 feet depth to a muck bottom.

Whiskey Creek

John LLoyd State Park is located on the east side of the intercoastal just south of the Port Everglades inlet. Very shallow but has access to the beach

The Spit

Anchor just east of the Intracoastal, north of Sheridan Street. A nice little basin bordering a small park.
